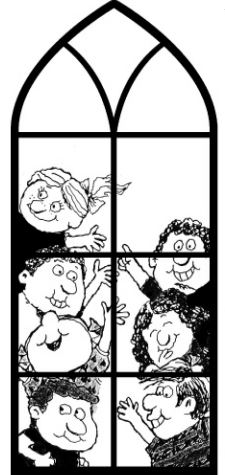
# Pleasant Green UMC Summer Camp
