

The disciples ask for more faith. The tax collector prays for mercy. Zacchaeus wants to see Jesus. These are the stories that have taken center stage in our worship throughout the month of October. These are the parables that have been teaching us something about how we understand our calling and our mission – and it involves Faith. Mercy. Pursuing the holy.

Pope Francis imagined the church as a kind of field hospital. Church as a place where sinners, the doubtful, the wounded, the disenfranchised could come and receive care and relief from their suffering. In the Protestant imagination, church has often been understood as a kind of school where we learn alongside one another. Early Christian thinkers likened the church as kind of gymnasium where we train and grow. A place where we develop strength, flexibility, where we stretch our muscles and embrace a life of training.

Another image people have used is that of a huddle, as in – a team huddling on a playing field. Ultimately, teams huddle to discuss, encourage, collaborate, challenge, critique --- for the sake of being sent out after the huddle. Whether we resonate with the image of a field hospital, a school, a gymnasium, or a huddle, there's no doubt that the church is a group exercise where we encourage, inspire, collaborate, challenge, critique, model, lead, follow, strengthen, learn, and heal. Week after week, we huddle – for the sake of being sent into the world. And in our worship, in our huddles, we have wondered – how can we bring more of God's mercy into the world? How can we be people of faith? How can we take up a life of pursuing God – climbing out on limbs, ultimately, inviting him into the most intimate parts of our life, around our tables, in our homes?

There are moments when it is easy to get discouraged – because it seems like the only "muscles" being strengthened in the world are the divisions, the building of walls, the fracturing of the church, hatred, anger, greed. The list goes on. We need a place where the suffering of the world can be healed. A place where our minds can be stretched and our hearts expanded. A place where we train for the Christian life. We need a field hospital. We need a school. We need a gymnasium. We need... the Church. To rekindle our faith. To receive God's mercy. To help us in our pursuit of the holy life. We

need to huddle together so that each and every week we can be sent out to embody God's mercy and grace in a world that is desperate for it. For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but rather a spirit of power and love and self-discipline.

My prayer for our church in the coming month is that we will rekindle the faith that we have been given. That we will become a people who not only receive God's mercy, but learn to live it in the world – feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, visiting the sick, giving drink to the thirsty, burying the dead; and that we will also pursue a holy and Godly life. I believe that opportunities abound to grow as disciples and to bear witness to God's goodness in the world. May we commit ourselves to this gospel and to this calling, knowing that God is with us and our faith is not in vain. Thanks be to God.


